

Tregonwell Academy Remote Education Provision

Remote Education Plan

In the event of a pupil or member of staff not being able to attend school, virtual learning lessons will be offered using Microsoft Teams. All pupils have their own account that will have a team for each lesson they receive in school. Where possible the lesson times of virtual lessons will follow the same lesson time of the onsite timetable. When any change in the provision is required, parents will be contacted via the pupils' tutor.

Remote Education Context

The school will work with each pupil and their parents/carers to ensure that the pupil has every opportunity to access virtual lessons. The school will attempt to remove any barriers to accessing lessons through the loan of laptops and provision of internet access. All individual needs of pupils will be supported as they would be if the pupil was in school, this includes access to any 1:1 intervention they usually receive. Engagement will be monitored on a daily basis with the tutor, the Virtual Learning Lead and Designated Safeguarding Lead.

Curriculum Planning and Delivery

Pupils will receive their normal sequence of lessons during any period of virtual learning to ensure that this does not prevent them from making progress. Live lessons will be supported by pre-recorded lessons where appropriate.

Safeguarding and Well being

Based on engagement during the day, the Virtual Learning Lead will meet with the Designated Safeguarding Lead on a daily basis. This will focus on pupils who have not been able to access virtual learning. Where appropriate, work packs and safe and well visits will be supplemented by daily phone calls from the pupils' tutor. Contact will be attempted with every pupil for every day they are not in school.
